A Focus on Healthy Food

Allegheny Health Network is taking a proactive approach to address food insecurity. In six years, AHN's Healthy Food Center has grown to six hospitals and has provided nearly 500,000 meals across the community.

The program—a partnership with the Greater Pittsburgh Community Food Bank—ensures patients have access to healthy foods and nutrition counseling to help manage their overall health.
