


340B PROTECTS ACCESS TO CARE IN PENNSYLVANIA

The 340B program allows eligible health care providers to purchase certain outpatient drugs at a discounted rate from drug manufacturers, at no cost to taxpayers, and partner with contract pharmacies to **get patients the right drugs, at the right time and in the right place**. Hospitals use these savings to support care for vulnerable patients and strengthen community services.

In Pennsylvania, 72 hospitals rely on the 340B program.
