
HOW MEDICAID CARES FOR PENNSYLVANIANS

Pennsylvania Medicaid Enrollment: 3M

23% of Pennsylvanians enrolled in Medicaid:

- · Children
- · People with disabilities
- Lower income adults (61% are working)
- · Older adults

Protecting Quality Health Care

Pennsylvania hospitals receive just **82 cents** for every dollar it costs to care for Medicaid and uninsured patients and rural hospitals receive **74 cents**.

The shortfall to Pennsylvania hospitals for caring for these patients totaled **\$1.9B** in FY 2023–24.

51% of Pennsylvania acute care hospitals are operating at a loss.


Care across the Lifespan

Pennsylvania Medicaid covers:


- About **35%** of births
- More than **1/3** of children
- Nearly 2/3 of all nursing home residents

Cost-Effective Care

Medicaid is a partnership between the state and federal governments to protect health care for children, people with disabilities, older adults, and low-income families.



Spending on Pennsylvania Medicaid



Medicaid per-enrollee spending has increased much less than other payors since 2008

Medicaid expansion increased health care coverage, resulting in hospitals absorbing **27.7%** less in uncompensated care, even though health care costs have increased.
